

## **ROUND HILL COMMUNITY CHURCH AND THE NAZIRI FAMILY: YEAR ONE**

RHCC has been giving financial aid and volunteer support toward establishing the successful residency of the Naziri family, who evacuated from Afghanistan during the takeover of the country by the Taliban. In their first year here community agencies and volunteers have helped in the following ways:

- The young male adults are all employed, and one young female adult is employed as a teacher's aide in a preschool.
- Some adult males have obtained driver's licenses and cars.
- Adult females have made good progress with "early conversational fluency" in English.
- Under-treated medical ailments have been addressed through a diversity of health care, dental, and rehabilitation solutions.
- Career-enhancing education for the employed sons has begun.
- Several school-age children have found academic stability and are progressing impressively, and a high school junior is receiving help in catching up to his peers in college preparation.
